Code Of Conduct

CULNC acknowledges and plays by the code of conduct outlined by All Nations stating the following:

1. Act respectfully towards officials. Never argue with, backchat or direct abusive language towards an official. If you disagree with an official, have your captain, coach or manager approach the official during a break or after the game in an appropriate manner.
2. Control your temper. The following is not acceptable or permitted:
 - (a) Verbal and physical abuse of officials, umpires or other players,
 - (b) deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent,
 - (c) rough, dangerous or violent play.
3. Play fairly and within the rules at all times.
4. Respect the facilities and equipment provided.
5. Avoid use of derogatory language based on gender, race or impairment.
6. Be a good sport. Acknowledge all good players whether they are on your team or the other team.
7. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
8. Co-operate with your coach, team mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
9. Play for the 'fun of it' and not just to win. All Nations is primarily about enjoyment and participation.
10. Be prepared to lose sometimes. Everyone wins and loses at some time. Be a fair winner and good loser.
11. Respect the rights and consider the safety of other participants, parents, administrators, coaches, umpires, officials and volunteers.
