

## **CULNC COVID-19 Code of Conduct**

### **Coach**

- i. Register upon arrival at a session.
- ii. Travel individually to training sessions – no car shares. Avoid public transport.
- iii. Set up of courts will be done by specific CULNC member(s) (up to 3 of - Club Captain, President, Club Vice-Captain, Swallows Captain, Swallows Vice-Captain) and Coach before other players enter the hall, following match set up diagram and guidance in EN Restart Guidance. - iv. Sanitise your hands upon arrival and departure and as otherwise necessary.
- v. As a coach, you are responsible for planning activities that support and enforce all EN current rule modifications, which are:
  - a. Any netball on a single court (outdoor or indoor if necessary) has a limit of 30 attendees including players, coaches, officials, selectors, sports science and medicine and administrators.
  - b. All players must not position within 4ft (1.2m) of any other player at the start of play. GS/GK are required to start inside the Goal Circle
  - c. 4ft marking - Increased from regular 3ft marking
  - d. 4ft position of penalised player
  - e. Removal of toss ups
  - f. Team talks should be conducted in socially distant circles on the court to avoid congesting the bench area
  - g. Social norms i.e. handshaking, goal celebrations, high 5's etc are not permitted
  - h. Shouting is not permitted
  - i. Players to sanitise hands at the start and end of every quarter.
  - j. A freshly sanitised ball will be used for each quarter with a spare clean ball kept in reserve. Post protectors will also be sanitised, so touching these is discouraged.
  - k. Personal items i.e. water bottles, are not to be shared and should be clearly marked. Bibs also won't be shared and will be washed after every session.
- vi. Time should be planned into every session for ball and hand sanitisation at least every 15 minutes
- vii. Maintain 2 metre social distancing at all times, especially when arriving, leaving or in team talks.
- viii. Wear a non-surgical face mask for indoor netball activity.
- ix. During an activity you are running please remind all players of the rules (as listed above) and enforce them.
- x. Check yourself and anyone else in your household for COVID-19 symptoms before you leave for netball activity. If you, or anyone in your household has symptoms, do not attend. If you have been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace as a result of being in contact with a known COVID-19 case, do not attend any netball activity and remain at home.
- xi. Any initial concerns relating to the enforcement of these rules should be reported to the CULNC COVID-19 Officer (Club Captain – Ciara Agnew), Club Safeguarding Officer (Vice-Captain – Jemima Currie) or another appropriate committee member.
